SPECIAL CITY COUNCIL MEETING

At 3:01 p.m. Mayor Darcy Paul called the Special City Council meeting to order in the Cupertino Community Hall Council Chamber, 10350 Torre Avenue and led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Park Improvement Manager Gail Seeds reviewed the staff report and introduced the consultant Cindy Mendoza, Senior Project Manager of MIG, Inc.

- Conduct a short focused survey that is representative;
- Parking will need to be addressed if a major facility is added.
