Subject

2018 Pavement Maintenance Phase 2 Project, Project No. 2019-102

Recommended Action

Authorize the City Manager to award a contract to Graham Contractors, Inc., in the amount of \$290,769 and approve a construction contingency of \$29,000, for a total of \$319,769.

Discussion

On July 24, 2018, the City received six bids for the 2018 Pavement Maintenance Phase 2 Project. This project provides for various preventative maintenance asphalt treatments on over 25 streets throughout the City. The majority of these streets are in residential areas on streets that are in fair condition. The timely application of a preventative treatment, such as micro-surfacing, will improve the pavement condition before it worsens and necessitates a much more expensive pavement treatment. The following is a summary of bids deemed complete:

The engineers estimate for this project was based upon the competitively bid unit costs of a similar project completed in 2017 plus an escalator of 20 percent due to recent trends. The favorable bids and number of bids received are likely a result of this project having a late summer start date.

Sustainability Impact

No sustainability impact.

Fiscal Impact

Award of the project will result in a fiscal impact of up to \$319,769. \$5,000,000 has been budgeted in account #270-85-821 900-921 (Pavement Maintenance). No further appropriation is needed.
