U-verse Programming Changes

AT&T contracts with programmers for the content displayed on U-verse TV® service periodically expire, or may be terminated, but are usually re-negotiated or extended with no interruption or change for our U-verse members. Additionally, from time to time it is necessary to change channel line-ups as well as television package contents. The programming changes set forth below may occur as follows:

August 2018:

As previously noticed, AT&T contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after August 2018: beIN Sports (channel 662 and 1662 in HD); beIN Sports en Español (channel 663, 3119 and 1663, 3319 in HD); STAR India PLUS (channel 3706); and The Word Network (channel 575).

In addition,

- 1) Spectrum Deportes (channel 778 and 1778 in HD) ceased broadcasting effective August 15, 2018;
- 2) World Fishing Network HD (channel 1679 in HD).

September 2018:

As previously noticed, AT&T contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after September 2018: CTI Zhong-Tian (channel 3604); ESTRELLA (channel 3024); MGM HD (channel 1116), as well as the following:

- 1) Los Angeles, CA area, KRCA (channel 62 and 1062 in HD);
- 2) San Diego, CA area, KSDX (channel 29 and 1029 in HD); and
- 3) San Francisco, CA area, KTNC (channel 42 and 1042/3024 in HD).

October 2018:

AT&T contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after October 2018: Bloomberg (channel 222 and 1222 in HD); BYU HD (channel 1567 in HD); GMA Pinyo (channel 3683); Havoc TV HD (channel 1490 in HD); Heroes & Icons (channel 137 and 1137 in HD); MBC America (channel 3643); Rai Italia (channel 3802); Saigon Broadcasting Television Network (channel 3662); TV Asia (channel 3703); The Filipino Channel (channel 3682), as well as the following:

- 1) Bakersfield, CA area, METV (channel 136 and 1136 in HD);
- 2) Fresno, CA area, METV (channel 136 and 1136 in HD);
- 3) Los Angeles, CA area, KAZA (channel 54 and 1054 in HD);
- 4) Monterey, CA area, METV (channel 136 and 1136 in HD);
- 5) San Diego, CA area, METV (channel 136 and 1136 in HD);
- 6) San Francisco, CA area, METV (channel 136 and 1136 in HD).

Customers will be provided with written notification of the above: customer bills include a message referring them to the Legal Notices in USA Today on the first and third Tuesday of each month, and to the AT&T website att.com/u-verseprogrammingchanges, for information on programming changes.
