What is Hep B?

Hepatitis B :

- Diseases that affects the liver
 - Liver cirrhosis, failure, cancer
- Vaccine preventable
- Caused by Infection of Hepatitis B virus
 - Birth
 - Blood
 - Sex



Silent Killer:

- Often dormant until too late to treat
- Screening
- Prevalent in Asian Communities
 - 1 in 12 Asians compared to 1 in 1000 caucasians
 - 4% of U.S. population but over 50% of US population affected

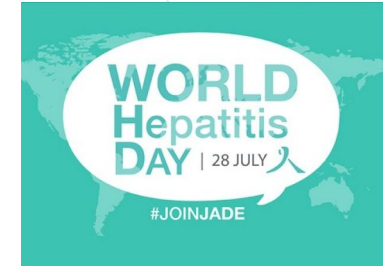
