NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cupertino hereby vacates the aforesaid easement, as shown and described per Document No. 10533472, recorded on May 23, 1990 hereto and made part hereof as Exhibits "A", pursuant to the provisions of Section 8320 et seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the City Council of the City of Cupertino that the City Clerk is hereby authorized, upon notification from the Director of Public Works that the Applicant has met all precedent conditions, to record the executed original Resolution in the Office of the Recorder of the County of Santa Clara.
