Additional funding for Additional Staff Hours at the Library

Recommended Action

Provide feedback to staff recommending a course of action.

Discussion

On October 25, 2018, the Santa Clara County Library District Joint Powers Authority (JPA) Board approved an increase of \$428,596 for additional staffing to support the Cupertino Library. The Cupertino Library Commission is asked to provide a recommendation among options on how to best use those funds to serve the Cupertino Community.

Options have been identified by the JPA board that either increases hours, adds the additional Go Go Biblio Library Outreach Services (10 to 15 stops per week), provide matching funds for dedicated programming space, or temporary suspend the City's current contribution for 12 additional hours, replacing those funds with the new staffing money.

The City's goal is to present a coordinated recommendation to the JPA no later than the 28th of February.
