Background

On November 20, 2018, Council made several changes to improve commission engagement with Council and standardize protocol among commissions and committees. Council also adopted Resolution No. 18-115 which adopted the City of Cupertino Code of Ethics and Conduct for Elected and Appointed Officials.

Discussion

At the December 18th Council meeting, Council directed staff to draft a resolution to rescind Resolution No. 18-115 which adopted the Code of Ethics and Conduct for Elected and Appointed Officials. Council also formed an ad-hoc subcommittee to draft a new Code of Ethics and Conduct. The draft will be brought back to Council for a study session no earlier than March 5, 2019. When the draft becomes available, staff will reach out to commissions and committees to gather feedback on the Code of Ethics and Conduct along with the other changes to commissions and committees regarding protocol and engagement with Council. This feedback will be brought back to Council for consideration prior to implementation.
