U-verse Programming Changes

AT&T contracts with programmers for the content displayed on U-verse TV* service periodically expire, or may be terminated, but are usually re-negotiated or extended with no interruption or change for our U-verse members. Additionally, from time to time it is necessary to change channel line-ups as well as television package contents. The programming changes set forth below may occur as follows:

February 2019

As previously noticed, AT&T contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after February 2019: GMA Pinoy (channel 3683); Heroes & Icons (channel 137 and 1137 in HD); MeTV (channel 23, 136 and 1023 and 1136 in HD); NHK World TV HD (channels 1221, 1379); SET (channel 3704).

As previously noticed:

- 1) Los Angeles, CA area, KAZA (channel 54 and 1054 in HD);
- 2) Monterey, CA area, KCBA (channel 35 and 1035 in HD);
- 3) Sacramento, CA area, KCSO (channel 25, 3007, and 1025 in HD).

Uverse TV subscribers will no longer have access to the My Coupons TV Offers application using the On Demand – VOD Menu or via Channel 199 beginning 2/25/2019.

March 2019

As previously noticed, AT&T contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer-term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after March 2019: NFL Network (channel 630 and 1630 in HD); NFL RedZone (channel 1629 in HD); and World Fishing Network (channel 1679 in HD).

April 2019

AT&T contracts with the programmers for the following channels are set to expire. While these channels will continue to be available to U-verse members so long as AT&T has the rights to carry them, if reasonable agreements cannot be reached with the programmers the programming will no longer be available. AT&T may modify the channel locations for the programming by moving them from their current channel locations to channels between 9501 – 9599, and if reasonable longer-term agreements cannot be reached with the programmers, we may lose the rights to carry them (listed in alphabetical order) in or after April 2019: A&E (channel 132 and 1132 in HD); A&E – West (channel 132 and 1132 in HD); Crime & Investigation Network (channel 163 and 1163 in HD); FYI (channel 272 and 1272 in HD); FYI - West (channel 272 and 1272 in HD); History (channel 256 and 1256 in HD); History – West (channel 256 and 1256 in HD); History en Espanol (channel 3104 in HD); Lifetime Real Women (channel 364); Lifetime Television (channel 360 and 1360 in HD); Lifetime Television - West (channel 361 and 1361 in HD); LMN (channel 362 and 1362 in HD); LMN — West (channel 362 and 1362 in HD); Military History Channel (channel 276); Pursuit HD (channel 1644 in HD); Sportsman Channel (channel 642 and 1642 in HD); Telemiami (channel 20 and channel 1020 in HD); Viceland (channel 257 and 1257 in HD); and Viceland - West (channel 257 and 1257 in HD).

In addition: Effective April 30, 2019, the following U-verse applications will no longer by available to U-verse customers:

- FITFUSION TV Featuring Jillian Michaels STB application (channel 440/633 and 1440/1633) and Interactive Menu,
- 2) Tumblebooks STB TV application (channel 345/1345) and Interactive Menu, and
- 3) U-verse Games STB TV application (channel 93/1093 and 321/1321) and Interactive Menu.

Customers will be provided with written notification of the above: customer bills include a message referring them to the Legal Notices in USA Today on the first and third Tuesday of each month, and to the AT&T website att.com/u-verseprogrammingchanges, for information on programming changes.
