

## **Summary of Terms & Conditions for Innerduct**

Verizon will install a manhole system with 4" HDPE conduit on select major thoroughfares in the City of Cupertino, subject to a revised wireless Master Lease Agreement (MLA). Verizon will install 3-1.25" HDPE innerducts inside the 4" conduit segments:

- 1 innerduct would be owned by City of Cupertino and labeled as such on engineering and as built documentation
- For any 3<sup>rd</sup> party companies that Cupertino allows use of innerduct the 3<sup>rd</sup> party would be allowed access under these conditions:
  - 3<sup>rd</sup> party provides engineering to Verizon for anticipated length of use
  - Enter and exit from Verizon owned Manholes 3<sup>rd</sup> party to provide knock out or core certification location
  - 3rd party must place their own hand holes for any cable coils, splice cables, and termination points. Notify Verizon
    in case Verizon wishes inspector to be on-site.
  - No intercepting of 4" conduit will be allowed
  - Cables must be racked and appropriately tagged by 3<sup>rd</sup> party
  - Other inner ducts are not for use and are required for Verizon maintenance
  - Coordination of Verizon and 3<sup>rd</sup> party is required in case of fiber cut or required relocations/roadmoves
