Athletic Field Use Policy Update.

Recommended Action

Receive an update on the progress of the Cupertino Athletic Field Use Policy.

Discussion

The City of Cupertino Athletic Field Use Policy has been established to ensure that all City-managed fields are utilized for recreational, athletic, cultural, educational, social and community service functions in a manner that preserves neighborhood quality of life and protects the park resource. The existing policy was established in 2004. A study of the current Athletic Field Use Policy became a City Council work plan item in 2019.

In January 2020, outreach to the youth sports organizations (YSO's) yielded minimal feedback. Staff is currently contacting the YSO's again for feedback about the field use policy and their field use needs. Based on the information received, staff will determine the next steps with the policy and move forward with community outreach.
