Items:

1. Include a photo or a slideshow at the top of the page with Teen Commissioners at events.
 - *Update:* Tentative; currently looking into the possibility.
2. Include dropdown or expanding menus with headers like “How to Apply”, “What it takes to serve”, “Our Work Plan”, etc.
 - *Update:* Will be included in the final template.
3. Include a table with upcoming meetings and agendas that connects to the Teen Commission calendar and teen events.
 - *Update:* Will be included. A ‘Teen’ category has been added by IT to pull teen items from City Calendar.
4. Include a “Contact Us to share your thoughts” section.
 - *Update:* Will be included in the final website with the teencommission@cupertino.org email.
5. Include a place where people can sign-up to get updates on meetings.
 - *Update:* A sidebar will be added and all residents who registered to receive e-notifications will receive notifications on upcoming Teen Commission meetings.
6. Replace rigid wording.
 - *Update:* Staff will make efforts to adjust language while adhering to the guidelines within the City’s Style Guide.
7. Improve “About Me” to include issues that are important to them.
 - *Update:* Each commissioner can choose to add a list of community issues they care about, in addition to three fun facts.
