#### PARKS AND RECREATION COMMISSION STAFF REPORT

## **Subject**

Community Feedback Regarding Playground Equipment Replacement Options for Creekside Park and Varian Park Tot Lots.

### Recommended Action

Receive an update on community feedback regarding playground equipment replacement options for Creekside Park and Varian Park tots lots.

#### **Discussion**

The Annual Playground Equipment Replacement Project was established in the Fiscal Year 2020-21 Capital Improvement Program with the estimated project cost being \$1,500,000 over five-years, \$300,000 annually. The purpose of the project is to address the replacement of older playground equipment that is dated and worn, starting with the Creekside Park and Varian Park two-to-five-year-old playgrounds. In alignment with the Parks and Recreation System Master Plan, staff researched options for themed playground equipment. To engage the community on the playground equipment theme options, a survey was conducted. Signs were posted at Creekside and Varian Parks on Friday, November 6 with information about the playground equipment replacement survey. Postcards were mailed to over 1,800 homes within a quarter mile of both Creekside and Varian Parks. The survey went live through the Open City Hall webpage beginning on Friday, November 6 and closed on Friday, December 4.

The public was provided two themes for each park to vote on:

- Creekside Park: sports theme or creek theme
- Varian Park: farm theme or nature theme

Survey results and community feedback will be brought to the Parks and Recreation Commission for their review.
