The Art Talk will be publicized on the City webpage, under the Fine Arts Commission website, as well as on the City calendar. The City's Communication Division also publicized the program on the City webpage and the City' social media channels.

It was recommended that Art Talks happen on a quarterly basis during the months of August, November, February, and May. Due to potential changes in public health guidelines, it is recommended that the Commission proceed with the planning of the November Art Talk, but delay marketing the event.
