The September 2021 fire reports for the City of Cupertino are enclosed.

Significant Events (Last Month): **21-2700007 Building Fire** This was a two-alarm fire in a two-story home. Property and content loss estimated at \$2,500,000. There was one civilian fatality associated with this incident. The incident remains under investigation. No injuries to emergency responders were reported.

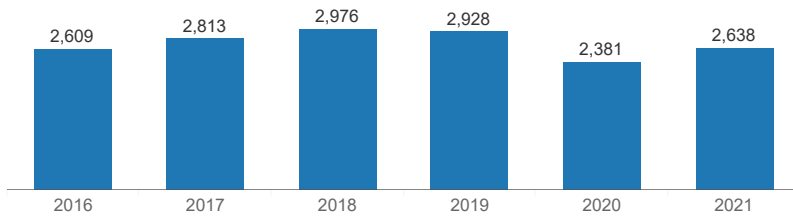

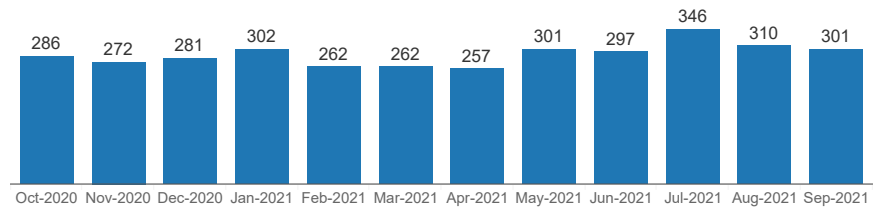

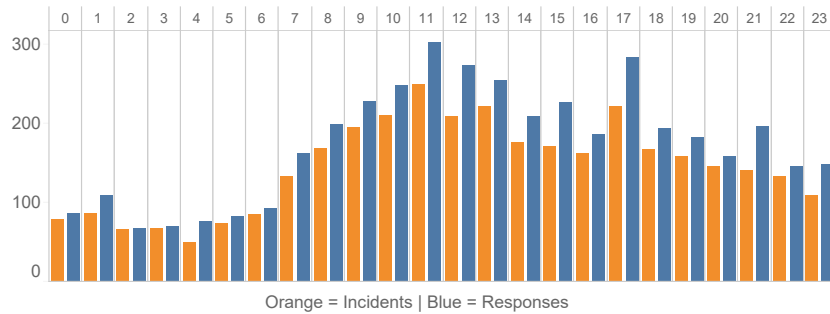
### Incident Counts by Year (YTD)

### Incident and Response Count by Hour of Day

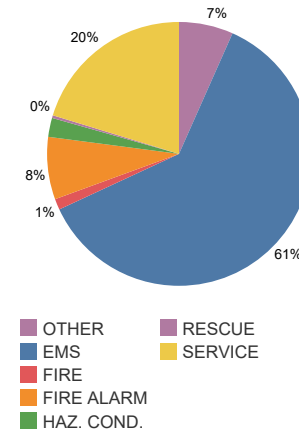

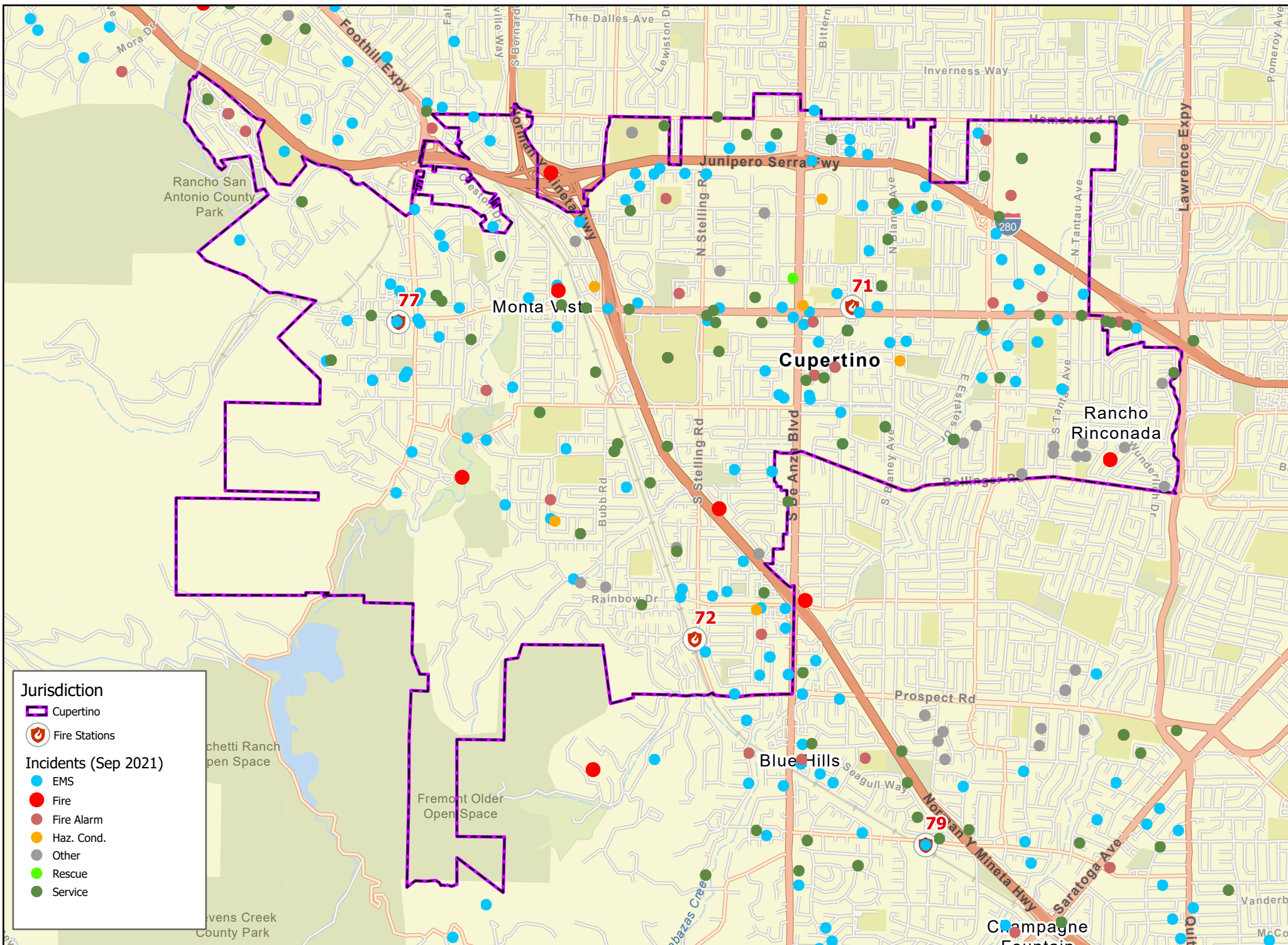
