Approval of a Mitigated Negative Declaration to allow Construction of a 47-space parking area, including a 27-space main parking area and an approximately 20-space overflow parking area, on an approximately 1.4-acre site that is currently used as an overflow parking area for activities at the McClellan Ranch Preserve

Discussion

- The Initial Study/Mitigated Negative Declaration includes mitigation measures for both the proposed 27 space permeable concrete paved lot and the future 20 space gravel paved overflow area to the north
- The Santa Clara County Water District reviewed the plans and would like for the City to install improvements in the parking area that will not block flood flows or raise water elevations. Revised plans have been submitted to the Water District. As the parking area scope of work will be outside the District's right of way, a permit from the District will not be required.
- There was discussion regarding the adequacy of 27 spaces. Staff stated that the future construction timeline of the overflow parking spaces will be determined after construction of the current proposed spaces has completed. It is important to see the usage/volume of the parking needs before committing to the additional expense.
