- ☐ To remove any contaminated soil from the site, soil be will graded three feet from the building foundations to a depth of 1 foot.
- ☐ Trees/Landscaping
 - o No trees will be removed during the nesting season

- ❑ Air Quality/Greenhouse Gas Emissions
 - Standard mitigating measures will be in place during construction to reduce dust and exhaust
- ❑ Hazardous Materials
 - The removed soil will be disposed in of in accordance with all local, State and Federal requirements.
- ❑ Utilities and Service Systems
 - The lots are subject to the State's C3 stormwater requirements, as such the lots will need to retain bioretention basins in a Public Works easement
- ❑ Traffic
 - The traffic study indicates that the traffic increase in the area will not have a significant impact
- ❑ Archeological/Cultural
 - There will be a Stop Work Order in the construction documents should any remains or artifacts be discovered on site
- ❑ Noise
 - Standard mitigating measures will be in place during construction to reduce noise
 - The noise study indicates that the overall noise generated from the project is less than significant
