Conduct the first reading of Ordinance No. 20-2200: "An Ordinance of the City Council of the City of Cupertino amending Title 3, Revenue and Finance: Chapter 3.12 (Transient Occupancy Tax), Revenue and Finance, amending Title 5, Business License and Regulations: Chapter 5.08 (Short-Term Rental Activity), amending specified chapters of Title 19, Zoning, of the Cupertino Municipal Code Chapter 19.08 (Definitions), Chapter 19.12 (Administration), Chapter 19.20 (Permitted, Conditional and Excluded Uses in Agricultural and Residential Zones) and Chapter 19.120 (Home Occupations), to regulate Short-Term Rental uses in residential zoning districts.
